


History of SPA

OFFSITE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW HOMES

SPA's framework for Off-site Construction of New Homes (NH2) is for the delivery of housing, apartments, multi-occupancy buildings including care homes, sheltered accommodation and student accommodation. Where a project is a mixed development of residential and commercial buildings or schools and community buildings, the framework may also be used to deliver the non-residential element.

This OJEU compliant framework is split into four workstreams:

- -- Workstream 1: Volumetric Systems
- -- Workstream 2: Panelised Systems
- -- Workstream 3: High Rise Project Systems
- -- Workstream 4: Turnkey Projects Low Rise

This framework provides local authorities, housing associations and other social landlords with easy access to offsite manufactured volutmetric, panelised, highrise and turnkey building systems for the use in new home build projects.

Valid until March 2023.

NEW HOUSE BUILDING

The Scottish Government has set the Scottish Housing Sector the ambitious target of delivering 50,000 new homes of which 35,000 are to be affordable housing by 2021, with a large number of these homes to be delivered through the AHSP (Affordable Housing Supply Programme). To support its partners who are planning to develop housing as part of this initiative, SPA's new House Building Framework has been designed to address many of the challenges developing authorities will face.

Suitable for use by all publically funded bodies throughout Scotland, the framework will be fully compliant with all Scottish, UK and European Public Procurement regulations.

The framework will offer the provision of new affordable housing, across all types of land including, but not limited to, brownfield, greenfield, landbank and landfill.
