- Launched in 2019
- Easy application process
- Aimed at more local groups & projects
- Events in May & November
- A community event, with soup followed by crumble
- The community decides the winner
- Applications for up to £1,000
- Six projects shortlisted to pitch
- All pitchers receive something

May 2021	16	90 – 2 events	£2,775
Nov 2021	11	69	£2,550

- Community café

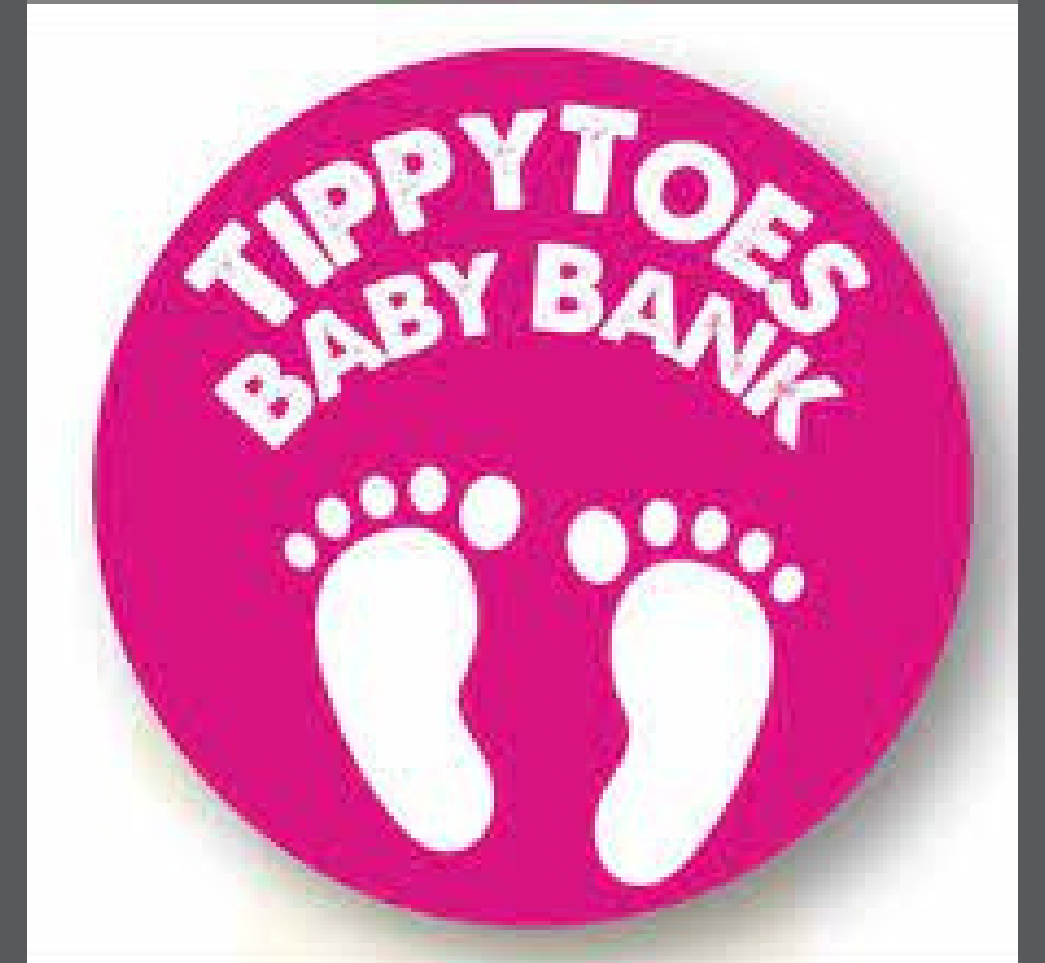
